A Safety Seminar (Safety Samvad) was held at Zonal Electric Traction Training Centre (ZETTC) Avadi, today (24.06.2024). More than 150 members of Loco pilots, Station Masters and Train Managers actively participated in this seminar.

Shri Kaushal Kishore, Additional General Manager, Shri Ganesh, Principal Chief Safety Officer, Principal Head of the departments of Southern Railway and Shri B. Vishwanath Eerya, Divisional Railway Manager, Chennai Division, Shri Tej Partap Singh, Additional Divisional Railway Manager II and other Branch officers participated in the seminar and addressed the gathering.
