Chennai Division gears up to combat the hazards posed by Cyclone Michaung

Chennai Division is in full preparedness to tackle Cyclone Michaung and has put in place a series of measures to combat the effects of unprecedented rains and gusty winds. Instructions have been issued to all the field units to be on high alert and exercise utmost vigil.

Concerted efforts have been undertaken to effectively mitigate the effects of the cyclone as detailed below:

Cancellation of train services:

- In view of water flowing above danger level at the bridge no.14 between Basin bridge and Vyasarpadi, express train services has been suspended. 18 express train services, including Chennai Central -Coimbatore Vande Bharat Express, Chennai Central-KSR Bengaluru Shatabdi Express, Mysuru- Chennai Central Shatabdi Express, Chennai Central -Tirupati Express, KSR Bengaluru- Chennai Central Brindavan Express has been fully cancelled.
- Train No: 22159, Mumbai CST-Dr MGR Central express will be short terminated at Arakkonam. Train No. 22160, Dr MGR Central has been partially cancelled between Chennai Central and Arakkonam and will originate from Arakkonam railway station at 16.30 hrs.
- Further, 3 trains have been diverted due to the rains.
- Chennai Suburban rail traffic across all the sections have been temporarily suspended.
 Passenger specials are being operated to clear stranded passengers.
