IMPLEMENTATION OF COVID VACCINATION CERTIFICATE IN SEASON TICKET IN CHENNAI DIVISION WITH EFFECT FROM 10TH JANUARY 2022

Government of Tamil Nadu, as part of its efforts to combat COVID third wave, has imposed new restrictions with effect from 04:00 hrs of 10.01.2022 to 23:59 hrs on 31.01.2022 (20 days).

As per the new restrictions, like normal commuters, Season ticket holders are also required to carry the Vaccination Certificate (Final Vaccination Certificate issued after the second dose) and produce the same for availing season tickets to travel in suburban areas w.e.f 10th January 2022. The 12 digit number of covid vaccination certificate (Final Vaccination Certificate issued after the second dose) will be fed in the Unreserved Ticketing System (UTS) before the issue of season tickets. The last 4 digits of the covid vaccination certificate number will be printed on the season tickets.

During the subsequent renewals of Season tickets, the last 4 digits of the vaccination certificate will be printed automatically upon feeding the UTS no. of the previous season ticket, akin to all other pre-fed details like Aadhar, Season ID card, etc. Existing season ticket holders should produce their second dose vaccination certificate to the railway officials during their travel.

Chennai suburban season ticket holders are requested to cooperate with Railways in ensuring safe travel during these pandemic times.

APPEAL TO RAIL USERS:

- Passengers are requested to adhere to all COVID appropriate behavior such as social distancing, wearing of masks and washing of hands at regular intervals while in the station and on board the train.
- ➤ Passengers are requested to co-operate with Railway employees for checking of your valid documents at stations and during the journey.
