The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to revise the rate of stabling charges of Rs.650/- per wagon per day or part of a day and is valid upto 31-03-2025 vide under reference(i), and the same extended for one month upto 30-04-2025 as per Board's letter under reference (ii).

Further, the matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to revise the rate of stabling charges from Rs.650/- to Rs.700/- per wagon per day or part of a day in case of all privately owned wagons including wagons owned by Container operators. The revised rate will be effective from 01-05-2025 and will remain valid for a period of one year.

- 1. Reference above, in terms of Rates Circular No.11 of 2024 dated 25.04.2024, the Operation of Merry-Go-Round (MGR) System by Railways is valid up to 30.04.2025.
- 2. The matter has been reviewed and the Competent Authority has decided to extend the validity of the system beyond 30.04.2025 for a further period of one year i.e. up to 30.04.2026.
- 3. It has also been decided that for the operation of the MGR system beyond 30.04.2025, the current rates shall be enhanced by 5% (five percent).
- 4. The Zonal Railways where the system is operative should monitor the same with a view to increase traffic.
- 5. All other terms and conditions stipulated in above referred Rates Circulars shall remain unchanged.
- 6. This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate and with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
