2023 Initiatives

Training on maintenance of public order and mob dispersal (From January to July-2023)

As desired by Railway Board, RPF Chennai Division has organized training on "Maintenance of public order and mob dispersal and availability of Arms & Ammunitions" for the Officers and staff of Chennai Division, Salem and ICF at RPF Parade Ground, Ayanavaram, Chennai, in batches. During the training, classes on Human Rights & Law, Fire Fighting, First Aid, Cr. PC Section 129 to 132 & IPC Section 96 to 106 (Right of Private Defense, Protection of Member of the Force, Riot Control Various Formations, Anti Riot Drill, Combat Fitness and Public Order management (both lecture & practical) were conducted. So far, 727 Officers/ staff underwent the training and the same is being continued.



Training on career motivation

IPFs-09, SIPFs-18, ASIPFs-83 (Total 110) from Chennai Division and SIPF-01, ASIPFs-2 & HC-01 from HQs/MMC attended the training under the supervision of Sr. DSC/MAS & ASC/W&S/PER.

Training Programme on Human Trafficking



On 20.02.2025, to sensitize the issues of human trafficking in Railways, Association for Voluntary Action (AVA) in collaboration with Railway Protection Force (RPF) and Government Railway Police (GRP) organized a training session to the Officers and staff of RPF & GRP of Tamil Nadu at Southern Railway HQs, Chennai. The training programme was inaugurated by G.M.
