



Action plan of identified stations of Southern Railway with reference to orders of Hon'ble NGT in O.A.No. 141/2014 in the matter of Saloni Singh & Ors. Vs Union of India & Ors.

S.No.	Order/Activities	Tiruchchirappalli Jn.
1	Provision of two bin dustbins for 100% collection of Municipal solid waste from all the stations.	Provisions are made for segregation of biodegradable and non-bio degradable at source by keeping 50 pairs of dust bins (i.e) green bin for bio-degradable waste and black bin for non-bio degradable waste. Signage stickers in trilingual form affixed for easy identification by users.
2	Management of Cleanliness staff	All statutory provisions of Labour Law like Minimum Wages, EPF, ESI, Bonus, Supply of Personal Protective Gears etc., are being ensured.
3	CCTV cameras installed for monitoring of littering.	CCTV cameras are already in place for monitoring of littering.
4	Public awareness campaign	Announcements and video display are being done at TPJ station regularly using Public Addressing System.
5	Achievement of Environment standard 'ISO-14001'.	TDC 30-04-2019
6	Water and Energy Audit to be undertaken.	WA - TDC 15-04-2019 EA -TDC 30-04-2019
7	Railway station should have their own website to receive grievances and suggestions particularly with regard to cleanliness and hygiene issues.	An exclusive website for Tiruchchirappalli Railway Station is being developed and will be operational from 31-03-2019.
8	Nos. of ETP/STP/WRP installed.	40 KLD capacity water recycling plant is available at BG Coaching complex.
9	Number of toilets provided in areas surrounding the track to prevent open defecation including provided by civil authorities. Also, coordination with urban local bodies for the same.	Sufficient toilets are available on all platforms.
10	Removal of Encroachments etc., in circulating and nearby areas.	Encroachment near TPJ station – Karumariyamman temple – Form A and B issued, waiting for date from local police for removal.
11	Collection, segregation and disposal of Plastic Waste.	Plastic bottle crushing machine is available. At present Tiruchchirappalli Jn. is having mechanized cleaning contract in which rag picking is included, the collected garbage is dumped at the nominated
