Commemoration of 112th Commissioning day of Chennai Egmore Railway station

Chennai Egmore railway station is one among the four intercity railway terminals in the city. This terminal connects the Southern districts of Tamil Nadu and Kerala. This Railway station serves as the gateway to the Southern Tamil Nadu. The station was built in 1906-1908 as the terminus of South Indian Railway Company and was commissioned on 11th June 1908. The building built in Gothic style is one of the prominent landmarks of Chennai. The main entrance to the station is situated on Gandhi-Irwin Road and the rear entrance on Poonamallee High Road.

Chennai Egmore railway station has 11 platforms where 24 Express trains are operated daily. 5 Weekly & Bi-weekly Express trains, 17 Weekly & Bi-Weekly passing trains operated via Egmore. More than 250 suburban EMUs are operated daily via Chennai Egmore railway station. This heritage railway station has a footfall of 1.2 lakh commuters on an average per day.

Commemorating the 112th commissioning day of present Chennai Egmore station, as a morale boosting activity, a cake was cut by Shri.S.B.Mathews, Dy.SMR (Operating), one of the senior most staff who is due for superannuation on 30.06.2020 in presence of on-duty staff duly ensuring hand sanitization and maintaining social distancing.
