Chennai Division operates its second BCACBM rake to Haryana on 11.08.2020

Chennai Division operates BCACBM rake to Farakha Nagar, Haryana carrying 270 cars. In association with TCI (Transport Corporation of India Limited), the maiden Automobile loading was flagged off today (11.08.2020)

The second rake of BCACBM commenced from Walajabad to Farakha Nagar (Haryana). The BCACBM rake which is owned by the firm (TCI) was operated with 27 wagons which carried a total of 270 cars of Hyundai car company. The total distance covered in the run between Walajabad to Farakha Nagar is 2306 kms with earnings of Rs,29,90,448. Atleast three such rakes in a month is expected for loading cars to various destinations.

As a part of the BDU (Business Development Unit), Chennai Division has joined hands with Transport Corporation of India Limited (TCI) for the first time, extending its business areas. It is noteworthy that the first rake was operated to the same destination on 01.08.2020 with 282 cars from Renault Nissan car company through Trac 1 logistics. And within a week time, Chennai Division has operated its second BCACBM rake from Walajabad.
