d. Implementation of COVID protocol in Railway Stations and Trains over Madurai Division :

- All Post Commanders and Outpost In-charges are instructed to assist the Commercial / Operating staff for formation of 'Q' system of train passengers at Railway Stations in their respective jurisdictions. Further, advised them to ensure the train passengers

to maintain Social distance, wear face masks, use of sanitizers during train journey.

- Pamphlets containing preventive / safety basic tips from spread of COVID 19 have been printed and are being distributed to the train passengers at important Railway Stations over Madurai Division.
- Awareness programmes regarding COVID-19 are being conducted by RPF at important Railway Stations over Madurai Division to create awareness amongst train passengers.
- In view of prevailing pandemic situation, announcements are regularly made through mega phone and PA system at all important Railway Stations over Madurai Division that the train passengers are to take all precautions like social distancing, wearing of mask, using of sanitizers, etc. during their journey in trains.
- Further, on arrival of the train, as far as possible the train passengers who get down from Trains at the Railway Stations, are immediately cleared from the Railway Stations by RPF personnel. In non-RPF Station, RPF escort party are advised to get down from the train and advise the detained passengers to immediately move out from PF area.
- In order to prevent from spread of COVID 19, the staff were strictly advised to wear face mask, maintain social distancing, use of hand sanitizers, to take Ginger, Turmeric, Zinc & Vitamin tablets and healthy / hygienic foods to improve their body immune system. Besides, staff were also advised to do breathing / physical exercises and Yoga daily.
