9. Public Health activities:

Cleaning of stations & colonies

- MMC Station under Mechanized cleaning contract for 04 years period from 01.04.2019 to 30.03.2023.
- 7 stations under imprest cleaning (MBM, PER, MLMR, TRL, AVD, TRT, AB) from 01.12.2020 to 01.05.2021
- Colony cleaning contract – Sterling Road, Pycrofts Colony, Rostover Colony, Chennai Egmore colony, Mathews colony for 04 years period from 11.09.2019 to 09.09.2023.

10. Achievements:

- All health units & DRH/AJJ worked with full strength during COVID lockdown.
- COVID vaccination centre started at HU/NGO; till date vaccinated 9600.
- In Chennai division overall number of persons vaccinated till date is 19200 and vaccination is continuing in different places.
- Cost saved by reducing 25% of colony cleaning and 66% of MMC station cleaning.
- Cost saved by changing contract cleaning to imprest cleaning at stations.

12. At DRH/AJJ:

- Sufficient quantity of PPE, masks, sanitizer etc made available.

14. Implementation of cost effective methods:

- During the lockdown period all Health units and DRH/AJJ worked with full strength of staffs 100% leading to huge cost saving and reduced the hardship of railway beneficiaries.
- Many webinars were conducted nominating one medical Officer for each department thereby motivating railway employees to get vaccinated against COVID and cleared their fears and doubts regarding COVID.

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
