Sub: Central Staff benefit Fund- Engagement of "AYUSH" Practitioners  
(Full Time/8 hrs. Clinic) at Railway Hospital/Perambur, Chennai,  
Southern Railway on contractual basis in the System of  
Indigenous Medicine

Ref: This Office Notification No. P(W)Con 641/1/7/AYUSH dt. 17.10 2023

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With reference to the notification cited, the following candidates are selected to work as AYUSH Consultant at Railway Hospital/Perambur on contractual basis for a period of 1 (One) year with an Honorarium of Rs. 75,000/- per month.

Based on the marks obtained in the Comprehensive assessment, the above candidates are selected for engagement as "AYUSH" practitioner on contractual basis under the aegis of CSBF in the respective discipline on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The Practitioner shall be engaged by the Central Staff Benefit Fund Committee and not by the Railway, hence he/she shall not be considered as a Railway Employee. His/Her engagement shall be on temporary basis for a period of ONE YEAR only. The engagement is likely to be terminated with 14 days' notice.
2. The engaged Practitioner shall be paid a consolidated honorarium of Rs.75,000/- P.M.(Rupees Seventy Five Thousand only) from Central Staff Benefit Fund, subject to availability of funds.
3. The engaged Practitioner shall be required to work in Ayush Clinic at RH/PER for 8 hrs. a day( 8.00 hrs to 16.00 hrs on Monday to Friday & 8.00 hrs. to 10.00 hrs. on Saturday). The dispensary will remain closed on weekly holidays and other gazetted holidays.
4. Casual Leave of 8 (Eight) days shall be permissible to the engaged Practitioner and no other kind of leave shall be admissible.
5. Deduction on pro-rata basis shall be made from the consolidated monthly honorarium for absence not covered by casual leave.

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6. No TA/DA shall be admissible to the engaged Practitioner and no expenses to join the new assignment shall be permissible.
7. No Railway Quarters shall be provided by the Railway Administration to the engaged practitioner during the period of engagement.
8. No medical treatment from the Railway Hospital is admissible to the Practitioner or his/her family members.
9. No Railway Passes/PTOs shall be permissible in favour of the engaged Practitioner.
10. The engaged practitioner shall not be allowed to issue any sick and fit certificate in favour of the Railway employees. Private practice shall be permitted but without hampering the normal duty in the Railways.
11. Services of engaged practitioner shall be terminated upon reaching the age of 60 years or after the completion of period of engagement, whichever is earlier. Even prior to these, the services can be terminated on 14 days' notice on either side. The Central Staff Benefit Fund (CSBF) Committee shall not be bound to assign any reason for such termination and this power may be exercised by the Chairman/CSBF Committee and the practitioner will have no right to challenge the order of CSBF Committee to this effect in court of Law.

This issues with the approval of Chairman/Central Staff Benefit Fund and Principal Chief Personnel Officer/Southern Railway.
