All SSE/P.Way/Salem Division.Sub: Filling up of vacancies Ballast Train Checker-II (Ex-cadre) in Pay
Matrix Level-04 in 7th PC (G.P.2400 in 6th PC) Engg Dept-reg.

It is proposed to conduct a selection for filling up of the post of Ballast Train Checker-II (Ex-cadre) in pay Matrix Level-04 (GP.Rs.2400 in VI PC). The number of vacancies proposed to be filled along with communal break up is as under:

1	Ballast Train Checker Gr.II Ex-cadre Level-4	01 (UR)	2 years of regular service as Track maintainer Gr.III

Volunteers are called for from eligible employees in the cadre pertaining to Permanent way units of Engineering Department of SA Division who fulfill the following eligibility criteria.

I. Eligibility :-

1. To fill up the vacancies of B.T.C. Gr.II in Level-4, Volunteers from Track maintainer-III working in Level-2 of VII PC with minimum 2 years of regular services as on date of notification will be eligible.
2. The post of Ballast Train Checker is Ex-cadre. The tenure of the post is maximum of 5 years on completion of 5 years of service as BT Checker they will be repatriated to their parent seniority unit.
3. The minimum educational qualification is X standard and sufficient working knowledge in English to prepare daily reports is desirable.
4. Medical classification requirement-AYE THREE. Employees qualified in the written examination will be subject to medical examination for AYE-THREE classification before empanelment, if they are not already fit in the same.
5. The selection will be based on written examination and there will be no viva-voce in terms of Rly. Bd's Letter No.E (EG) I/2000/PM 1 / 4 dt.07.08.2003
6. Those employees who have secured minimum 60% of marks in written examination will be considered for further selection process based on record of service. The selection will be finalized entirely on merit as per the instructions contained in RBE No.113/2009 dated 19.06.2009 circulated vide PBC No.121/2009 and PBC No.54/2012.
7. Employees empanelled for the post have to undergo training at MDZTI/TPJ for the prescribed period.
8. Employees who fulfill the above conditions and who are willing to apply for the ex-cadre post of BTC Gr.II may please submit their application as per proforma in ANNEXURE "A" through their supervisory officials concerned so as to reach this office on or before **18.09.2023**. The Supervisory officials should verify the applications and certify the correctness of entries before forwarding the same.

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9. Syllabus for the written examination is in ANNEXURE "B".
10. The employees working in Construction Organization whose lien is maintained in SA Division are also eligible to apply. Supervisory officials of Construction Organization should certify while forwarding the applications to the effect that they are holding lien in SA Division.
11. The employees are permitted to answer the written examination in "Regional Language" in terms of instructions contained in Railway Boards Lr.No.E (NG)I/90/PM /41 dt.08.07.1992. The terms "Regional Language" as used here means official language of the state in which the office where the employees concerned are working is located. Employees desirous of writing the examination in regional language shall specify the name while submitting their willingness. **However, they will have to appear and pass a separate test in English to be held in the afternoon on the day of written Examination.** Option once exercised will be final and no alteration will be entertained. No change will be admitted at the time of Examination.
12. The cut-off date determining the eligibility of the staff should be the date of issue of notification. As such, the volunteering employees should fulfill the educational qualification and other service conditions as on the date of notification. i.e, as on 28.08.2023.
13. In the event of employees being selected they should be prepared to proceed to any Station within SA Division to which they may be posted and if they do not agree to this, they need not appear for the selection.

IV. Procedure for written Examination & drawal of panel:

The selection consists of written test. As per Railway Board's Letter No. E (NG)1/2018 PM1/4 dated 14.12.2018 (RBE No.196/2018), the question paper will be 100% objective type multiple choice questions for the written examination and 10% of the total marks will be from official language policy and rules (which will be optional).

There shall be negative marks for incorrect answers. One third of the marks allotted for each question will be deducted for wrong answers. Cutting, overwriting erasing or alteration of any type in the answer sheet will not be accepted. Zero marks will be given for answer having correction/overwriting.

As BTC Gr.II in Pay Matrix Level-4 is an Ex-cadre post filled by calling volunteers, the panel will be determined on the basis of order of merit among those who qualified in the written examination. There is no weightage for seniority.

There will be No Supplementary Examination

V. Last date for submission of Applications:

All supervisory officials concerned are advised to give wide publicity in this regard. Application from eligible volunteers in the prescribed Proforma to be collected by the Supervisory Officials and sent in one bunch with a covering letter (showing the names of volunteers) to reach this Office **on or before 18.09.2023.** The office of the covering letter should be kept on file at the unit for future verification whenever needed.

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The supervisory official shall also affix their signature & date while forwarding applications to this office. Incomplete applications, application received after the last date shall be summarily rejected. In case of no volunteers for the above selection, a "NIL" statement may be sent to this Office. Applications received after the last date prescribed will not be entertained.

The applications received after 18.09.2023 will not be entertained.

ANNEXURE-B**Syllabus –Ballast Train Checker**

1. Different types of Ballast Trucks in use of Engineering Department their category etc, (General Knowledge about BTCS)
2. Knowledge about various kinds of Ballast used for Truck, as also items of permanent way materials, their weight with relation to the carrying capacity of each vehicle.
3. General Knowledge about haulage capacity of engines normally allotted for BT working number of vehicles with lead the engine could haul etc, in the different section with reference ingredients etc.
4. Knowledge about standard specification for working Ballast Train for contractions and contractions responsibilities, and duties of Ballast checkers and Guard etc.
5. Knowledge about the functions of the Guard in charge of Ballast Train.
6. Preparation of daily reports, calculation of useful Engineering lower of Ballast Train working etc.
7. Knowledge about departmental procedure followed in collection of Ballast and distinguishing between measured and unmeasured stacks at the quarry.
8. Capacity of locate Ballast stacks enumerated for being trains out of PWI, ADEN, etc, and measuring and arriving at quantity of part stocks left behind.
9. Capacity of group instructions given regarding quantity to be unloaded at each location, regarding telegraph posts.
10. Knowledge about the safety rules and other framed for the unloading of Ballast (ie) at clear distance from the track unloading clear of signal wires.
11. General knowledge about provisions of employment of Children's Act, Employment of women etc for loading and unloading and Hours of Employment Regulations.
12. General knowledge about the rules governing the working stabling of Ballast Trains etc, as provided in CRS.
13. Duties when any Ballast labourer or labourers get injured in the course of work and writing report on the occurrence.
14. Action to be taken when BT get cancelled due to want of power or guard resumption of BT working.
15. Any other rules relating to Ballast Train working especially applicable to be concerned Engineering or Traffic department.
