

BRIEF HISTORY OF TRIVANDRUM DIVISION

Trivandrum Division was formed on 2nd October 1979 carving out Shoranur-Cochin Harbour Terminus section from the east while Palghat Division and Ernakulam-Trivandrum-Kanniyakumari sections of Madurai Division. The division is spreading over the areas of Kerala & Tamil Nadu. The route kilometrage of the division is 562.36. This division is mainly passenger oriented as it serves the area with highest density of population.

The Medical department of TVC division provides comprehensive health care services to employees, their dependants and retired employees. Apart from the Divisional Hospital at Thiruvananthapuram Pettah there are 6 six Health Units

The Railway Hospital at Pettah was commissioned on 15.11.1991. This is a 54 bedded hospital located at Pettah, Trivandrum, opposite to Pettah Railway station. Details of services rendered and facilities available.

FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Medical Department is organising various Health and Family Welfare programmes all over the division for awareness among railway men as part of preventive medicine. As part of preventive medicine various health awareness / detection camps are organized all over the division.

PUBLIC HEALTH & SANITATION

The Medical Branch carries out works related to cleanliness of stations and colonies, water chlorination, lifting of food samples under PFA etc. for which Health Inspectors have been posted at all major stations. A Medical Officer designated as Sr.DMO/H&FW/TVC is nominated as the in-charge of Health & family welfare activities of the division...
