


Sub : Inter Railway one way request transfer of Commercial Clerks in Pay Band Rs.5200-20200 with Grade Pay RS.2000-regarding

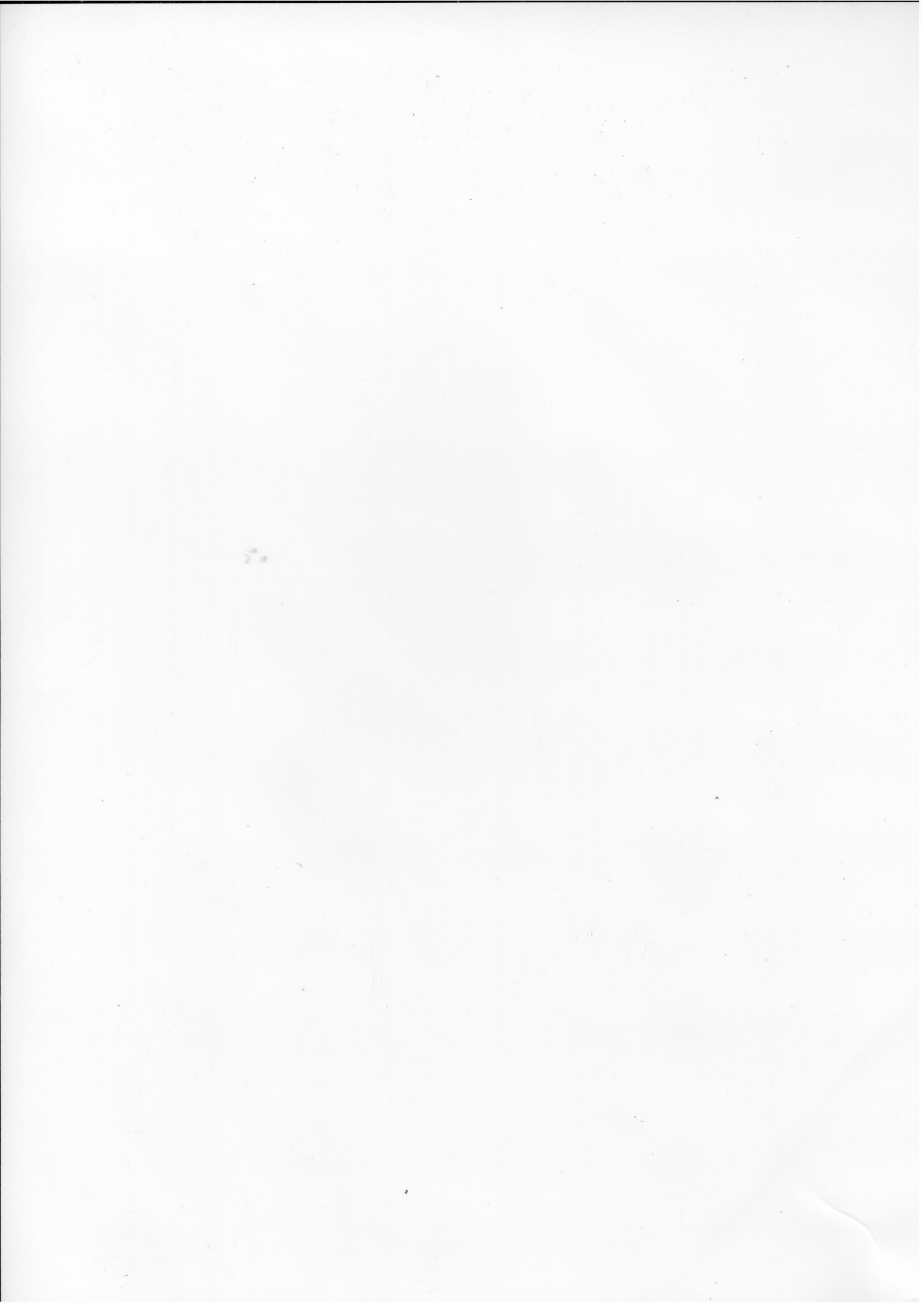

1. They will rank junior most to all permanent /officiating Commercial Clerk in Pay Band Rs.5200-20200 + GP.Rs.2000 in Madurai Division/Southern Railway on date of their joining in the new seniority unit.
2. They will not seek re-transfer to their parent unit/Railway at a later date.
3. They will not be eligible for Composite transfer grant/transfer Pass, Joining time etc., since the transfer is ordered at their request.
4. There are no DAR/SPE/Vigilance cases pending against them on the date of relief.
5. The employees may be relieved with instructions to report DRM(P)MDU/Southern Railway for further posting
6. The relieving Memorandum/Order sparing the employee should have the photograph of the employee pasted on it duly attested in the manner viz., the


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
